Martha,

If you only need a couple of bullets, I would suggest:

The Flow Rate Technical Group continues work to refine estimates of the oil flow rate from the riser before the Top Hat device was installed

BP has provided new video that will be used by the Plume Analysis Team to estimate the flow rate after the riser was cut; results may be available by the end of this week

The Mass Balance Team is finalizing their report, which also may be available by the end of this week

The Reservoir Analysis and Nodal Analysis teams are proceeding with data collection, analysis, and modeling

Marcia, are you comfortable with these, especially mentioning these possible timelines? Is there anything else you want to add?
