



**Marcia: your thoughts on release of a "preliminary" Nodal Team report**

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Hi Marcia,

I spoke with George Guthrie today about some data confidentiality agreement issues (still working to resolve; will update you later as needed) and his thoughts on when to release their Nodal Analysis Team report. As you probably know, his Nodal Analysis team received some initial reservoir characteristic parameters and has been setting up and running full nodal models using those prelim parameters. The intent was to work through the models and see how the results look using these initial parameters, then refine and redo once the Reservoir Team provides new parameter values.

The four independent Nodal analysis teams have completed their preliminary analyses. So George is at a point where he has two options:

- 1) put his team on standby until the Reservoir Team numbers come in, then reanalyze and generate his report to FRTG
- 2) generate a preliminary Nodal Team report by next Monday or Tuesday, then update and provide a final report to FRTG once the Reservoir Team numbers are available

Both scenarios allow us to meet our final FRTG report deadline (last week of June).

Given some of the challenges we have faced with preliminary and revised estimates from the Plume Team, I recommend option 1 (wait and do only one report). What is your preference?
