A busy day in the Gulf for our crew. It looks like we have the boats lined up. The first crew will head out to the spill site tomorrow morning to match the AVIRIS over-flight. The other boat will be out near shore over the weekend during a corresponding AVIRIS mission. NASA flew a successful AVIRIS flight today over the Chandeleur Islands, LA and Pensacola, FL for an ARTEMIS Overpass. We also continued onshore sampling and calibration measurements of heavily oiled, lightly oiled, and un-oiled areas.

Tomorrow should be a busy day, we'll see what we can accomplish.
