Marcia,

A few quick points from the July 9th 0630 brief.

Weather good; currently 2-3' seas

Subsea Dispersant: still steady at 8 gal/min. 24 hr total = 11,511 gal

Recovery (past 24 hrs): Enterprise = 16,308 B; Q-4000 = 8,091 B; total = 24,399

Enterprise

Time = 114 hrs; will lighter on Saturday
Blue Pod is on the bottom, ready for deployment
Will test high pressure hydrate washing system

HP1 has completed the punch list: will be "ready to produce" on Saturday
Top Hats being placed on the bottom

After the 1200' is placed, all ROVs will come up for repairs before proceeding. Have already started repairs for 3 ROVs.

CDP1: 1200' pressure test failed; they found small leak in tubing fitting in gooseneck. Plan to tighten. Can still use if leak is small. Will proceed with methanol flush.

DDIII: Confirmed RR#9 results; 6.2 +/- 1.2 feet from well. At 4 deg angle; need to get down to 2-3 deg.
Now at 17,780' - will drill to 17,830 and do RR#10 today
May get to the casing by Tuesday
